Erratum, Primary Source Additions, and Citation Expansions

This document corrects documented factual errors in the main text, adds primary source citations from the released Epstein files, and expands sourcing for key claims. It should be read as an addendum to the main text.

All sources cited herein are either (1) independently documentable public record, (2) released Epstein files now in the public record, or (3) third-party investigative reporting by named outlets, clearly labeled as such. Courts determine guilt. This work is public interest scholarship and First Amendment expression.

SECTION 1

Documented Factual Corrections

Error 1 — April 27 date conflation

Error as published: In the main text, April 27 appears in connection with events that require clarification. April 27, 2016 is the documented date of the Mayflower Hotel meeting in Washington D.C. at which Trump met with Russian Ambassador Sergey Kislyak and other Russian officials. This meeting is independently documented in Special Counsel Mueller's report and Senate Intelligence Committee materials.

Corrected text: Donald Trump's documented birthday is June 14, 1946 — not April 27. Any passage in the main text conflating April 27 with Trump's birthday is incorrect and should read: 'On April 27, 2016 — at the Mayflower Hotel event — Trump met with Russian officials.' The date's significance is the documented Russian contact, not a birthday coincidence.

Error 2 — Attribution of personal biographical claims

Error as published: Several passages in Appendix B attribute specific personal biographical details to the [uprightsnews.com](#) editor as documented fact rather than as claims reported by [uprightsnews.com](#).

Corrected text: All specific personal biographical claims about the [uprightsnews.com](#) editor — including dates, locations, specific events, and personal experiences — should be understood as claims reported by [uprightsnews.com](#) and consistent with their documented framework, not as independently verified facts. The distinction matters legally and factually.

SECTION 2

Primary Source Additions — Released Epstein Files

The following primary source documents from the released Epstein files, now in the public record at epstein-file-explorer.com, corroborate specific claims made in Chapter 13 of the main text regarding the Edge Foundation network. These documents are cited here as independent corroboration of what was previously reported through second-hand sources.

Subject: Edge Foundation Billionaires' Dinner Planning — Palo Alto, December 8, 2014

Document content: John Brockman emails Jeffrey Epstein directly (jeevacation@gmail.com) planning a December 8, 2014 gathering in Palo Alto, California. The email confirms: (1) the event was being planned at either a private home, the Four Seasons Palo Alto, or a Stanford academic setting such as CASBS; (2) Lucy Page (Larry Page's wife) had offered her second house for the event; (3) Maja Hoffmann was confirmed as a speaker, described as giving a talk on her art center in Arles (LUMA Foundation), her collection, and her activities as 'Queen of Art Basel'; (4) the confirmed guest list includes: Tony Fadell, Ev Williams, Sara Williams, Salar Kamangar, Larry Page, Lucy Page, Anne Wojcicki, Elon Musk, Jeffrey Epstein, Dave Morin, Brit Morin, Ginevra Elkann, Maja Hoffmann, Marina Abramovic, Hans Ulrich Obrist, Katinka Matson, and John Brockman.

Significance for Chapter 13: This document directly corroborates Chapter 13's documented claim that Epstein, Maja Hoffmann (Roche/LUMA Foundation), Larry Page (Google), and Elon Musk

were convened together at Epstein-funded Edge events in the 2014-2015 period — precisely the period documented in the Paradise Papers as Russian state capital was being deployed in Facebook and Twitter through Yuri Milner.

Subject: Edge Foundation Event Planning — Confirming Attendee List

Document content: A related document from the same period confirms the identical attendee list for the December 2014 Palo Alto gathering, including Maja Hoffmann's role as a speaker on the LUMA Foundation. The document confirms Brockman's role as organizer and Epstein's role as financial patron of the gathering. The document is archived at epstein-file-explorer.com as part of the publicly released DOJ Epstein records.

Significance for Chapter 13: Corroborates the documented network connection between Epstein, Brockman, Hoffmann, Page, and Musk in the pre-2016 election period. Together with EFTA00357054, these documents constitute primary source evidence from the Epstein files themselves confirming the Edge Foundation network documented in Chapter 13.
